

Local Consultations – An Invitation

Future Use of the Former Mount Neighbour School Site

As part of the ACT Government's *School Revitalisation Policy*, 23 schools and preschools either closed at the end of 2006 or are to be closed over the next two years. The Government is consulting the community about the future use of 16 of these former schools and preschools located on 13 sites. It is also consulting on the former North Curtin and Downer primary schools that were closed several years ago.

The Government has announced that five of the sites referred to above will be disposed of, including the Mount Neighbour site.

The Government has commissioned a team led by Purdon Associates to undertake the community consultations and in the case of the sites for disposal to make recommendations on the preferred use or uses for the sites.

Input from the community will help decide the best future uses for this site.

LOCAL COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

There will be a community information session at which the local community can provide input into the planning process for the Mount Neighbour site.

The community information session will take the form of an open display where residents may drop in at a convenient time to review the available information, speak to the consultants about future use of the site and provide comments.

Plans and other information will be on display and your views on the site will be appreciated.

The consultants will be in attendance to discuss site information, community issues and planning options.

While the ACT Government has decided that the site should be sold, the consultations will focus on the potential form of future development.

WHAT HAPPENS FOLLOWING CONSULTATION

The consultants will make recommendations to the Government after the consultations about the sites for disposal are completed.

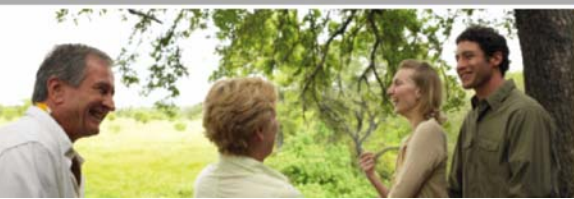
Following a decision about the future use of the site, it is anticipated that the site will be sold, possibly in 2008.
